

# Forchini Vineyard Dry Creek Valley 2014 Old Vine Zinfandel

**T**he elevated eastern bench land above the Dry Creek valley floor has provided this historic ranch a history of grape growing since 1886. This acreage features 2 acres of 50 year old Carignane and 12 acres of 100 year-old Zinfandel still in production. It has an ideal location for fully ripe clean fruit of intense varietal character on Zinfandel.

## TASTING NOTES

Tempting, rich aromas of dark cherry and plum are laced with traces of fine herbs and cocoa. A delicious mouthfeel reveals luscious blackberry, juicy cherry and a touch of milk chocolate with hints of savory baking and wood spices. Slightly chewy when first opened, this Zin will be delicious with a New York steak with a spicy coffee rub, or duck sausage tossed with dried cranberry, crisped sage leaves and butter sauce.
