**T**reborce Vineyard is situated on the high “Airport” bench of Dry Creek Valley. It has a constant breeze in the vineyard in the afternoons, so Treborce Zinfandel grapes aren’t as susceptible to some of the issues that creep up locally, due to the area’s prevalent fog. This small property’s grapes are consistent winners, due to the love and attention the owners give to them.

*Soil: Gravelly loam*

*Clone: Bernier and Mazzoni*

*Rootstock: 110R*

*Trellis: Cordon-trained*

*Harvested: September 2014*

*Composition: 100% Zinfandel*

*Alcohol: 15.9*

*Total Acidity: .60 gm/100ml*

## TASTING NOTES

“Layered with depth” aptly describes this complex Zin, starting with the dark aromatics of ripe brambly berries and toasty oak. The velvety texture and juicy entrance to the palate are further enhanced by the richness of the flavors—blackberry, boysenberry and hints of raspberry and huckleberry. Traces of black pepper, baking spices and caramel layer throughout the wine, along with a subtle citrus thread. Supple tannins and notes of oak caress the palate as the wine flows to the finish, where its structure makes a bolder statement.

Enjoy it with sausage and sage stuffed mushrooms, or pork tenderloin rolled with chorizo and spinach.
