This unique blend offers layered and complex aromatics of jammy blackberry, espresso, forest floor, worn leather and oak notes. The velvety entry quickly merges with robust flavors of mixed dark berries, ripe cherry, spicy black pepper, coffee, anise and traces of cedar. Slightly chewy tannins appear mid-palate, along with a creamy mocha essence that merges with the dark flavors as they coat the palate and remain in the finish. Delicious now, this wine will continue to develop with additional bottle aging.

A great wine to sip while gathered around the fire, or to pair with slow roasted pork with mole sauce and molten chocolate cake for dessert.
