TASTING NOTES

Nearly opaque in appearance; this rich full bodied Petite Sirah has layer upon layer of sweet black plum, violets, and spice. The nose is filled with nutmeg, mocha, and hints of star anise. With its precise varietal characteristics of blueberry and spiced sugar plum exploding on the palate. Mouth filling velvety tannins, ending with a warm, dry, and lingering finish.
