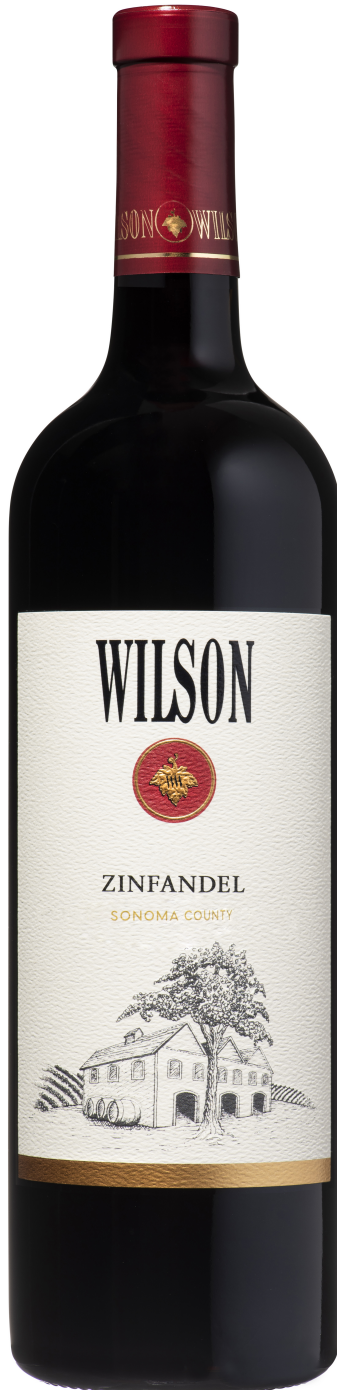




2018 Sonoma County Zinfandel

TASTING NOTES

Bright red fruits along with a subtle hint of spice, greet the nose. Aromas of cranberry, cherry, and hazelnut are balanced by baking spices. A lively palate constructed of ripe strawberry, vanilla, and clove come alive with the first sip. This vintage has a ripe mouth coating texture, and delicious flavors that linger on the finish.

Pappardelle bolognese with ground filet mignon, pork, garlic, carrot, onion, tomato topped with ricotta and parmesan cheese.
