TASTING NOTES

Glints of purple, red, amber and violet all catch rays when this spicy wine is twirled in a sun-filled glass. Jammy and spicy on the nose, fruit scents of sweet raspberry, thicket-ripened blackberry, and buttery cranberry come forward, along with a hint of caramel. The flavors do not disappoint, with bright red fruit being showcased, and a healthy dose of spice. With moderate tannins and good acidity, this Zin is less jammy and more elegant than the nose would lead you to believe and showcases a lovely vanillan creaminess.
